

2020 IJAA/CIAA Field Day Covid-19 Agreement

The Illinois Junior Angus Association and Central Illinois Angus Association have made changes to the show to assure that the show could be held safely. We are sure that you are aware that most livestock shows, county fairs, and state fairs in the Midwest have been cancelled. It was no small feat that the Illinois Junior Angus Field Day was approved. Your IJAA/CIAA Board of Directors worked very hard and spent many hours working together to reformat the show to meet the guidelines put in place. We did this because we want to bring back some sense of normalcy to the lives of our junior livestock exhibitors. We understand that exhibitors and their families have invested both time and money into their projects and one of the rewards of that investment is being able to attend a show. We hope you will be understanding that our event will be different this year. Some of the decisions we made were difficult, but were made to follow the guidelines expected of us if we wanted the show approved to be held. Our desire to offer you and your child a show is great, but our desire to keep you and your family safe while participating in our event is even greater. Please keep this in mind throughout the weekend and be respectful of our volunteers that are simply carrying out what is being expected of them. Be patient, be kind, be responsible, and let's all enjoy getting your kids back in the show-ring!

IJAA/CIAA Covid-19 Guidelines:

- If you exhibit any Covid-19 symptoms, or do not feel well the day of the show, please stay home.
- Only direct family members should attend the show with their exhibitor. This event is not open to the public and extended family is not encouraged.
- Exhibitors should know there is a health risk and if someone becomes ill, anyone attending the show may need to be tested and could be quarantined.
- IJAA/CIAA will strongly encourage the use of face masks or cloth face coverings when social distancing is not possible.
- While at the show, practice social distancing by maintaining 6 feet from people other than the family members you have arrived with.
- No more than 10 exhibitors in the ring at one time.
- Judges and show-chairmen will have their own workspace/tables/chairs.
- No bleachers will be provided this year.
- No standing around the show ring and make-up arena. Please only be up around the show ring when your exhibitor is showing.
- Queens, Princesses, and Ebonettes will be required to wear gloves while handing out awards.
- Disinfectant spray and hand sanitizer stations will be provided around the facility.
- No 'congregating' with friends at your stall space.

- This form will be posted on the IJAA website. It should be thoroughly read, signed, and submitted at check-in. If you do not submit the signed form, your exhibitor will not be allowed to show.
- There is still a chance that the federal government, State of Illinois, McLean County or City of Bloomington could impose further guidance or restrictions that would prohibit this event from happening, but as of 6/11/2020 there are no such orders in place.
